The House, co-working space for the creative business sector in Royal Tunbridge Wells.

Refurbishment work on 29-31 Monson is nearing completion ahead of its official launch on the 30th September from 2 o'clock. The offering is already proving extremely popular with contracts in place for over a ½ of the available space and others in the pipeline.

The aim of this project is to provide much needed affordable commercial space for small businesses, freelancers and start-ups working in creative industries, an area for which Tunbridge Wells is already well known. Once up and running The House will promote a collaborative environment where people across the creative sector can work together to the shared benefit of themselves and their clients.

With prices from £145 per month, The House will have 50 desks, 20 hot desks and a meeting room. The shared space, with kitchen and garden will double up as venue space that will host networking and training events for local businesses.

The property, which is owned by the Borough Council, is best known as the old home of the Citizen's Advice Bureau, located next to the Pickering Centre right in the centre of town.

Following a study to explore opportunities for the creative business sector in Tunbridge Wells, the Borough Council along with Kent County Council have invested in the set-up of the new co-working space in order to support the continued growth of this important and vibrant sector.
